# Your Critical Thinking Questions (developed by the CTP Citizens Jury 14<sup>th</sup> October 2017)

### Relevance

- Is it within the Jury's boundaries/scope?
- How was the process for you?
- Is this something we can change?
- Is this accounted for elsewhere in the system?
- Is it within our remit?
- Who is relevant to be covered?
- What is expected of CTP?
- Are the words "third party" subject to change?

### Clarity

- What do you mean when you say...?
- What is the critical element / issue on what you said?
- Can you simplify?
- Can you rephrase?
- Can you expand on that?
- Can you break that down?
- Can you expand on the context?

# Accuracy

- What assumptions have been used?
- What is the source?
- What supporting document do you have?
- How is it funded?
- What is your expertise?
- What is the reliability / measure?
- Could you explain your method or process?
- Is this value or data driven (money)?
- Are there accurate ways of summarising / determining values?

#### Breadth

- What would doctors, psychologists (etc) think about this process? Other than legal?
- Is there a different way of looking at this?
- Could the government levy? (including kangaroos, bicycles etc)
- What does your competition say?
- How much is this is associated with your profits?
- What raw data has been disregarded?
- Where is the transparency?

## Depth

- Can you give us a practical example?
- What is the counter view to that?
- Have you considered all the impacts?
- Are there contrasting opinions on this topic?
- Is there another way of doing that?
- Can you expand on each point or dot point?

# Logic

- Does the evidence support the conclusion?
- Can I believe what I am being told?
- Does this answer the question or solve the problem?
- Consistency? With values, aims, needs and expectations.
- Contradictions? (data)
- Where does the evidence fit?
