Has active frontages that promotes passive surveillance










HOUSING CHOICE

A mix of housing typology, and social community is preferred

































DIVERSE AND CONNECTED


An outdoor, connected park system with a focus on retention of existing facilities and opportunities for afterhours activities




LANDSCAPE INTEGRATION
