

# Overview: Phase 2 Consultation for Coombs Play Space at Holden's Creek Pond

August 2019

### Background

A Play Space is currently being planned for Edgeworth Parade, adjacent to Holden's Creek Pond. The Play Space is intended to be an inclusive play space with something of interest for all ages as well as visitors to Holden's Creek Pond and the Molonglo River Corridor. The plans for a Play Space are in accordance with the Coombs and North Coombs Estate Development Plans, and the Coombs Landscape Strategy,

To inform the draft design of the Play Space, the Suburban Land Agency (SLA) engaged with the community through both face-to-face and digital methods in order to understand what facilities and play elements the Play Space should consider and how it should look and feel.

A draft design incorporating that feedback was then released to the community in early 2019.

Communication Link, on behalf of the SLA, is undertaking a second round of engagement with the community to gather feedback on the draft design.

## Objective of stakeholder and community engagement

The objective of this engagement program is to gather and record additional feedback from interested stakeholders on the proposed size, scale and inclusions in the new Coombs Play Space at Holden's Creek Pond.

# Stakeholder engagement approach

Communication Link will engage key organisations, community representative groups and individual community members through face-to-face meetings, events, localised door-knocking and online platforms over a six-week period between August and October 2019.
