

# Common Ground Dickson – Pop-up Information Session Demographic Data

Over the eight week period, Housing ACT met with a range of stakeholders to discuss the concept designs for Common Ground Dickson, including community resident groups and councils, leaseholders and neighbours within Section 72, and the broader community by way of pop-up information sessions, with ten consultation events held during the engagement period. There was an additional presentation to the ACT Aboriginal and Torres Strait Elected Body outside of the eight week period, which six people attended.

In total, 90 people participated in face-to-face discussions, with 59 of those people attending the four pop-up information sessions that were held. Information was captured on number of attendees, approximate age group\*, gender and whether they stopped and talked (engaged) and if they took any information or engagement collateral with them.
