Key features of the district



Transport and movement infrastructure and services

- Light rail is proposed to be extended to Weston Creek to connect the district with Civic and Woden Valley.
- There are rapid bus services connecting Cooleman Court with Civic and Woden Valley.

Description

- The district was established c.1970.
- There are 8 suburbs in the Weston Creek district: Chapman, Duffy, Fisher, Holder, Rivett, Stirling, Waramanga and Weston.

Urban intensification and infill opportunities

- There is an urban intensification area at Cooleman Court (Weston Creek group centre).

Centres and employment clusters



- Cooleman Court is the main group centre serving the district (and currently also the Molonglo Valley community).
- There are local centres at Chapman, Duffy, Fisher, Holder, Rivett, Waramanga and Weston.



Community and recreation facilities

- There are good community facilities with gyms, sports, medical, community groups and playgrounds.
- There are a number of education facilities (including primary schools, high schools and colleges) in the district.



Housing and other buildings

- The district has a range of older and new dwellings, particularly in the areas rebuilt after the 2003 bushfire.
