NEW PUBLIC SCHOOL IN THROSBY

Throsby's new public school will provide the community with a state-of-the-art education facility focused on providing a great education in both indoor and outdoor learning areas.

The school accommodates 132 preschool students and 450 Kindergarten to Year 6 students with space available for future student growth. It features a large community room and kitchenette, multipurpose double gym, sports courts, and change-room facilities, as well as an outdoor turf sports field and outdoor multipurpose hard courts.

The new primary school in Throsby is Canberra's 90th public school and third zero emissions school in its operations, with a focus on sustainability.



As an important facility for Throsby, we asked the community to tell us their preferred option for the name and the school uniform.

The community voted for:

School name: Throsby School

School uniform: Eucalyptus leaf concept

THE CONVERSATION

We held a conversation between 7 October to 15 October 2021 using the ACT Government's Your Say online voting function and the feedback helped us finalise the different aspects of the school's visual brand.

WHO ENGAGED?


The engagement process saw 5,811 views of the Your Say site, with 2,652 unique visitors. 498 people voted on the name and uniform options. Overall, 502 items of feedback/votes were received.

Gender of participants




Woman: 340 contributed, or 68%

KEY INSIGHTS FROM THE COMMUNITY

Naming the new school

Throsby School was selected by the community as the favourite name for the new school.

At the request of the Minister for Education and Youth Affairs, the Directorate asked the Office of the Surveyor-General and Land Information and the Place Names Committee for options to name the school. The name options include eminent Australians (deceased) whose contribution is related to the suburb theme and include the names of women and the names of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples.

Family members, former colleagues and organisations closely associated with these individuals were also consulted to obtain their support to have the name considered as one of the options for the new school.
