

Dear Resident,

We are writing to you to provide an update on the new Gungahlin Tennis Facility project proposed for Amaroo

Last year, the ACT Government committed to construct a new tennis facility in Gungahlin, in partnership with Tennis Australia and Tennis ACT, to enhance tennis facilities for Canberra's growing northern region.

The facility will include 10-12 full sized courts, hot shots courts, a hitting wall, LED lighting, parking, and a pavilion.

The facility represents a considerable investment in new sport and recreational facilities within the Gungahlin region, with the ACT Government having committed to provide \$8 million in the new facility and an additional \$400,000 contribution from Tennis Australia and Tennis ACT.

The site identified for the new facility is the northern section of the Amaroo District Playing Fields (West of Horse Park Drive and East of Jorgensen Street).



In the coming weeks, the ACT Government will be engaging a consultant to assist in the preparation of a site masterplan (also called an Estate Development Plan). Important design considerations that will be addressed will include the management of stormwater, traffic and site access and facility parking.

As the plan progresses, we will provide the community with more information about the project, and you will have an opportunity to have your say.

We look forward to hearing your thoughts on the project in the coming months.
