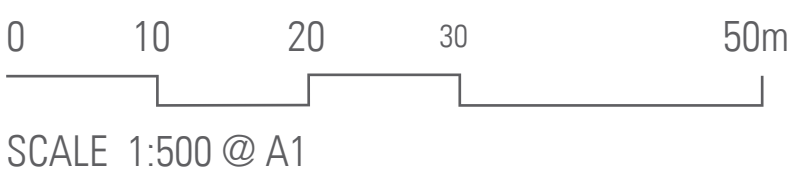

DESIGN NOTES

- 1 MAIN TENNIS COURTS AND ASSOCIATED LIGHTING COMPLYING WITH THE INTERNATIONAL TENNIS FEDERATION FOR COURT DESIGN.
- 2 HOT SHOT TENNIS COURTS
- 3 TENNIS HITTING WALL.
- 4 PROPOSED PARENTS SEATING AREA WITH TREE PLANTING FOR SHADE.
- 5 POTENTIAL AREA FOR FUTURE DEVELOPMENT INCORPORATING ADDITIONAL TENNIS INFRASTRUCTURE.
- 6 PROPOSED CENTRAL PAVILION SERVICING THE FACILITY.
- 7 AREA ALLOCATED FOR POTENTIAL FUTURE EXPANSION.
- 8 PEDESTRIAN PATHWAYS PROVIDING DDA COMPLIANT CIRCULATION ACROSS THE SITE AND TO ALL TENNIS COURTS. PROPOSED PATHWAYS CONNECT INTO THE SURROUNDING ACTIVE TRAVEL NETWORK.
- 9 DENSE TREE PLANTING ALONG WESTERN BOUNDARY TO PROVIDE SCREENING TO ADJACENT RESIDENTIAL AREA THAT SITS HIGHER THAN THE PROPOSED FACILITY. MATURE TREES ARE PROPOSED TO ACHIEVE SCREENING AS EFFICIENTLY AS POSSIBLE.
- 10 PROPOSED TREE PLANTING TO PROVIDE A NATURAL PERMEABLE BOUNDARY TO THE SITE.
- 11 PROPOSED SPECTATOR VIEWING AREA UTILISING THE EXISTING TOPOGRAPHY.
- 12 PROPOSED GREEN LINK THROUGH EXISTING EASEMENT PROVIDING TREES WHERE POSSIBLE OUTSIDE THE EASEMENT EXTENT. TURF IS PROPOSED THROUGH THE EASEMENT WITH POCKETS OF LOW GRASSES AND GROUNDCOVERS CREATING A MEANDERING CONNECTION THROUGH THE SPACE TO GIVE THE EFFECT OF A CONTINUING PLANTED CORRIDOR.
- 13 2x DESIGNATED ACCESSIBLE PARKING BAYS AND 40x PARKING BAYS.
- 14 WASTE ENCLOSURE AREA.
- 15 PROPOSED CULVERT CROSSING
- 16 HORSE HOLD OFF AREA.
- 17 EXISTING ACTIVE TRAVEL NETWORK.
