

Phase 1 of Consultation: **Sharing**

On Monday 21 November and Monday 7 December, community members were invited to review and ask questions on a new Territory Plan and the draft Inner South District Strategy. The new planning system will deliver better outcomes for communities, the environment, and people across Canberra.

Communication Link hosted 2 pop-up sessions on Monday 21 November and Monday 7 December, to share information about the proposed Territory Plan and the draft Inner South District Strategy. The pop-ups provided the community with an opportunity to clarify their understanding with guidance from ACT Government representatives.

Following the pop-ups, Communication Link hosted a follow up workshop with presentations from representatives at the Environment, Planning and Sustainable Development Directorate on the draft new Territory Plan the draft East Canberra District Strategy.

Planning system

Community members expressed interest in learning more about the planning system and to gain a better understanding of technical terminology used in planning.

Public Transport

Community members raised a need for an increase in bus connections and expressed a distaste for the tram line.

Inclusivity

There were several comments about the need to increase accessibility for people with disabilities through the likes of wider doorways and lifts.

Heritage

Community members had several questions around how heritage protection would fit into the District Strategies.

Territory Plan

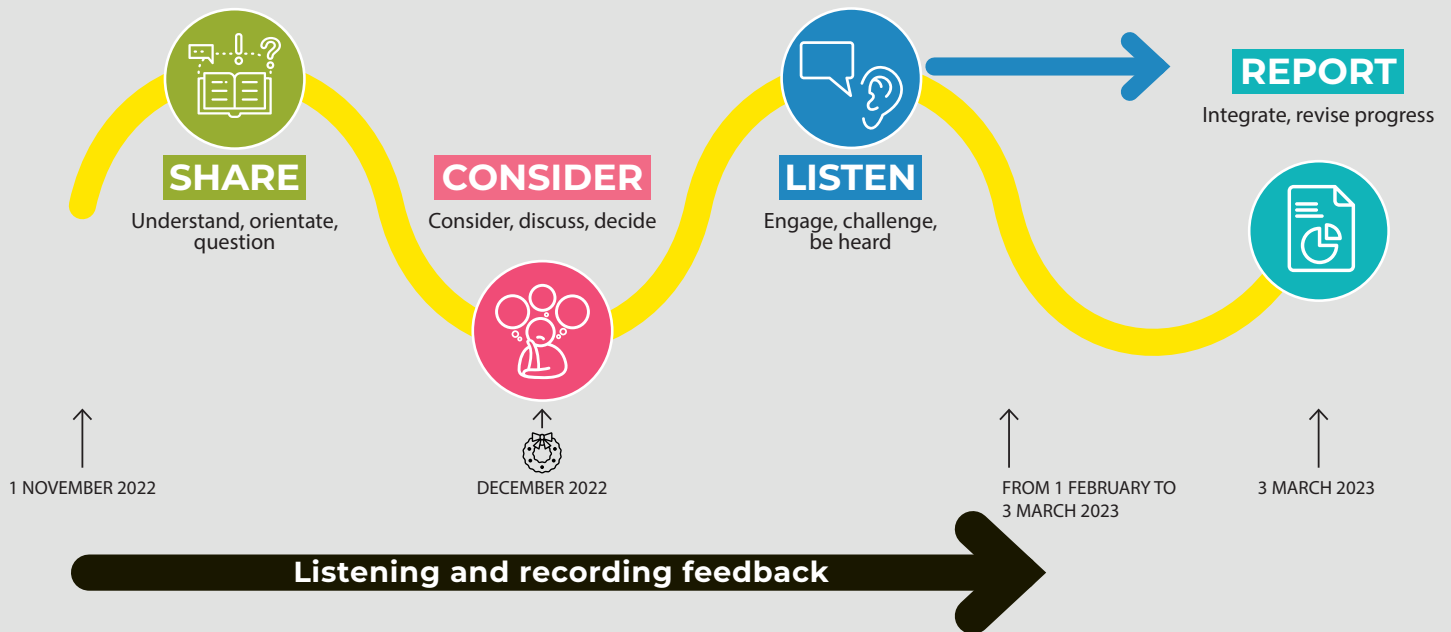
Community members expressed a concern for the lack of clarity in the new Territory Plan and felt confused about what has changed.
