# Woden District



## Phase 1 of Consultation: Sharing

On Tuesday 22 November 2022, three events were held in Woden as part of the sharing and learning phase of the PSRR consultation project.

Communication Link hosted 2 pop-up sessions on Tuesday 22 November, to share information about the proposed Territory Plan and the draft Woden District Strategy. The pop-ups provided the community an opportunity to clarify their understanding with guidance from ACT Government representatives.

Following the pop-ups, we hosted a follow up workshop with a video and presentation from representatives at the Environment, Planning and Sustainable Development Directorate on the draft new Territory Plan the draft Woden District Strategy.

The objectives of the workshop were to:

- 1. Inform interested people about the draft district strategy and the draft new Territory Plan
- 2. Encourage understanding to support participants to give feedback on the new proposed planning system.
- 3. Collect questions and feedback on the draft documents and other elements of the proposed planning system and provide feedback to workshop participants.

## **WHAT** WE HEARD

Participants were invited to ask clarification questions about the Woden District Strategy and draft Territory Plan. Areas of question and feedback are summarised below.

#### Social

Community members raised concerns about the lack of opportunities for teenagers and the younger demographic.

## **Existing Plans**

Community members generally wanted more information on how existing plans interact with the draft Woden District Strategy Plan

#### **Active Travel**

Community members wanted more safe active travel routes.

#### **Public Facilities**

Community members asked if there are opportunities to introduce new public facilities such as Art centres and a new aquatic centre.


#### **Environment**

Community members wanted more information on how the new planning system will reduce the impact of construction on our environment.

#### Consultation

Community members wanted more opportunities and time for consultation, given the proximity of the Christmas holiday period.
