

Inner North playground

Final indicative design

Key

1 Parkland entry area

Includes access paths, tree planting and features on the ground such as steppers.

2 Existing mound

Install limestone blocks in the existing mound to create informal access. Also features gravel access routes and plantings.

3 Amphitheatre viewing and seating

Install limestone blocks in the existing mound to create seating.

4) Open grass area

Space for informal use close to formal play areas.

5 Fitness area

A range of fitness equipment targeting whole of body strength and circuit training.

6 Skate elements

Use the existing slopes in the land to provide skating opportunities.

- 7) Two multi-use courts
- 1. Full size tennis court including pickleball line marking, three basketball hoops and one netball hoop
- 2. Half size basketball court with a hit-up wall and line marking for games such as handball/4square, twister, hopscotch and maze.
- 8) Bike repair station Install a bike repair station equipped with an air pump and tools to repair bikes.
- 9 Central activity zone

Activity area including a shelter, three-phase power, accessible seating, a barbecue, drinking fountain and bins.

10) Play space area

Equipment includes swinging, climbing, agility and group play elements.

11 Accessible play route

A signposted path will link the network of accessible play equipment.

12 Junior play space area

Aimed at toddlers and young children. Includes swinging, sensory, exploration and nature play elements.

(13) Open grass space

Space for informal kickabout activities, picnics and gatherings.

14) Public toilet

One accessible cubicle restroom including baby change facilities.

15 Accessible parking

Two accessible parking spaces with centre clear space off Burton Street.

16) Future carpark location

Proposed location for a future carpark.

17 Connected path network

Accessible and connected paths throughout the parkland and to existing/future network links.

18 Existing trees

Retained and protected.

(19) On street parking

16 new on-street car parking spaces on the northern verge of Windeyer Street.

← Maintenance access

Access routes for maintenance and management of the facilities. Via paths.

20) Storage container

Storage container will be available for local community groups to utilise and store equipment.
